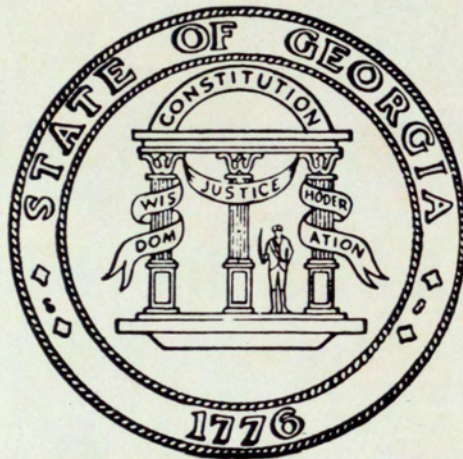

# History

Plans are under way for a new ten-story building to house the Atlanta Division, University of Georgia. When these plans are completed work will begin on the first portion which will consist of two floors under street level and three above. The present building will be rented except for the mezzanine rooms where laboratories will be maintained after the new structure is occupied, but it's still in the embryonic stage.

Each year there is a great need for more space and each year the school has expanded greatly. The present building has 89 classrooms, eight laboratories, five auditoriums and a 25,000-book library in comparison to the three small rooms occupied by the parent school in 1913.

A second library, with the same capacity as the present one, is under construction on the sixth floor of the school. Of the five auditoriums, three were added in the past year for use as study halls, art galleries and movie theaters. These are all air-conditioned and will seat from 100 to 200 students.

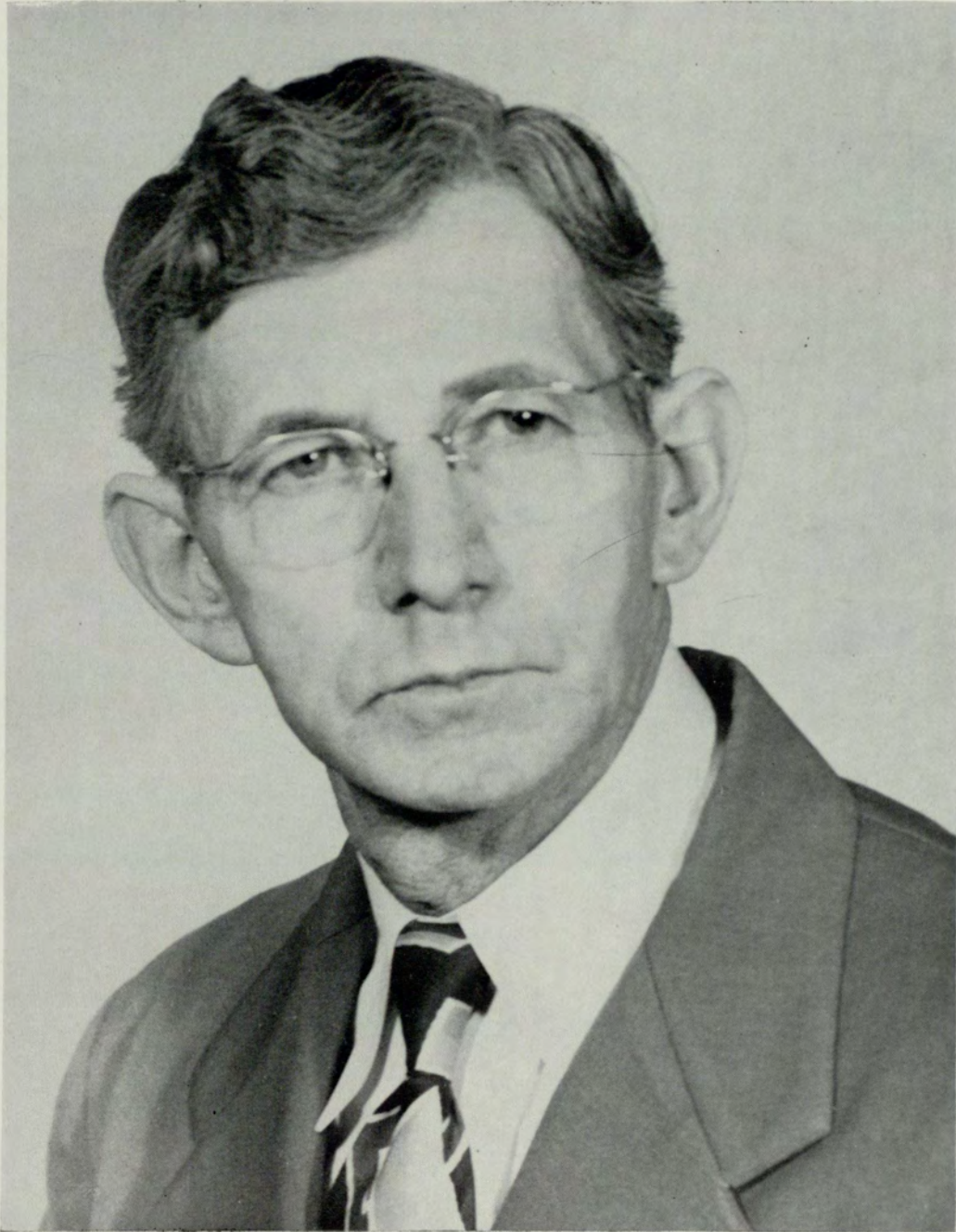
This year, out of the more than 5,000 students registering, 672 had never before attended the Atlanta Division. Many others were turned away because of lack of classroom facilities and instructors.

Unparalleled progress has been made by the Atlanta Division in bringing business and educational relations closer with both students and faculty members having outside business responsibilities.

In keeping with the times, new courses have been added in the fields of labor, retailing and law. Over thirty instructors were added to the faculty, most of whom are holding important positions in Atlanta's business world.

With such progressive spirit and strong background, the Atlanta Division, University of Georgia should continue to expand and keep its place as an integral part of our growing metropolis.

## *Honorary Organizations*

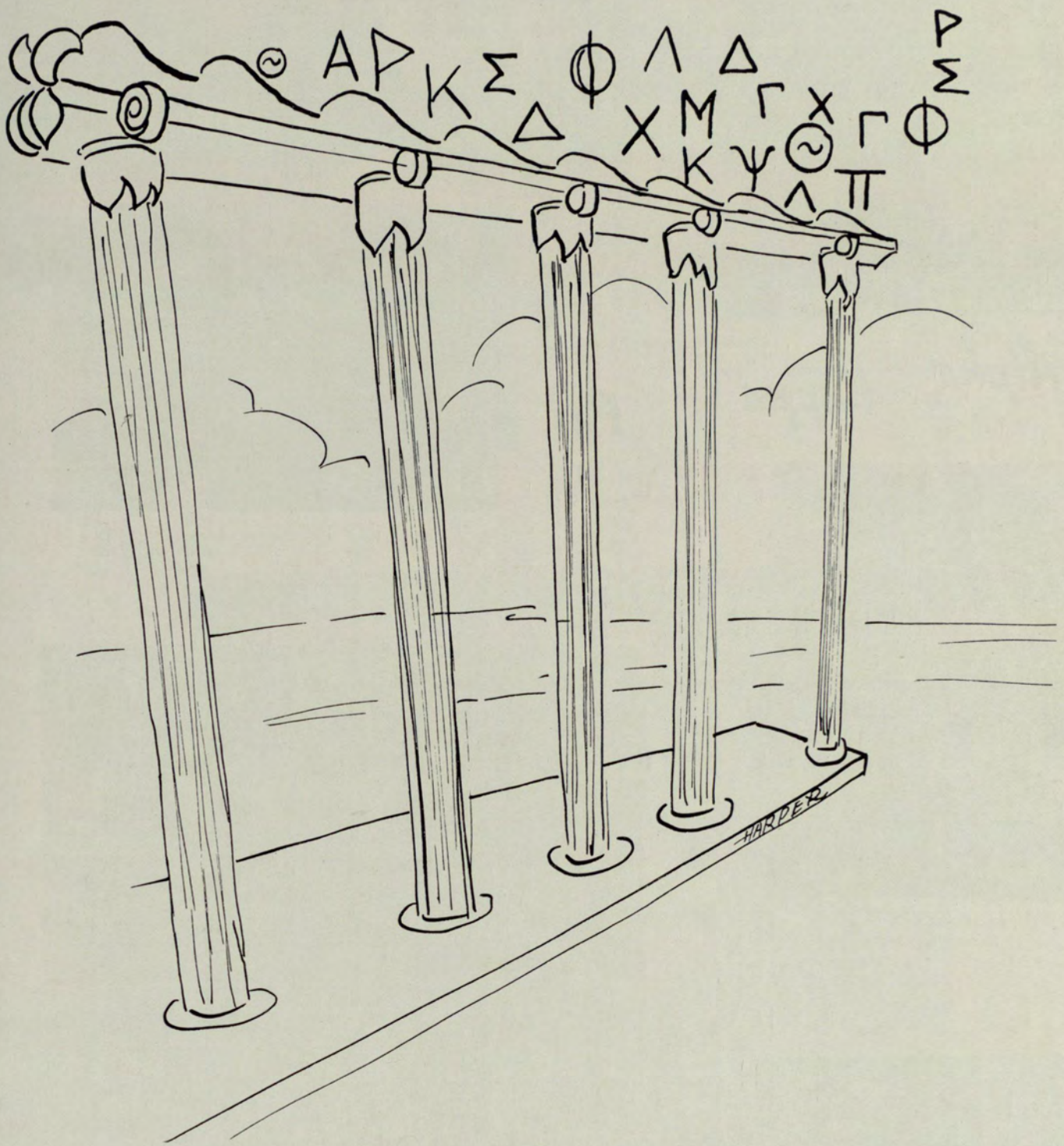
The three honorary organizations of the Atlanta Division, University of Georgia are Delta Mu Delta, Intramural Key and Crimson Key.

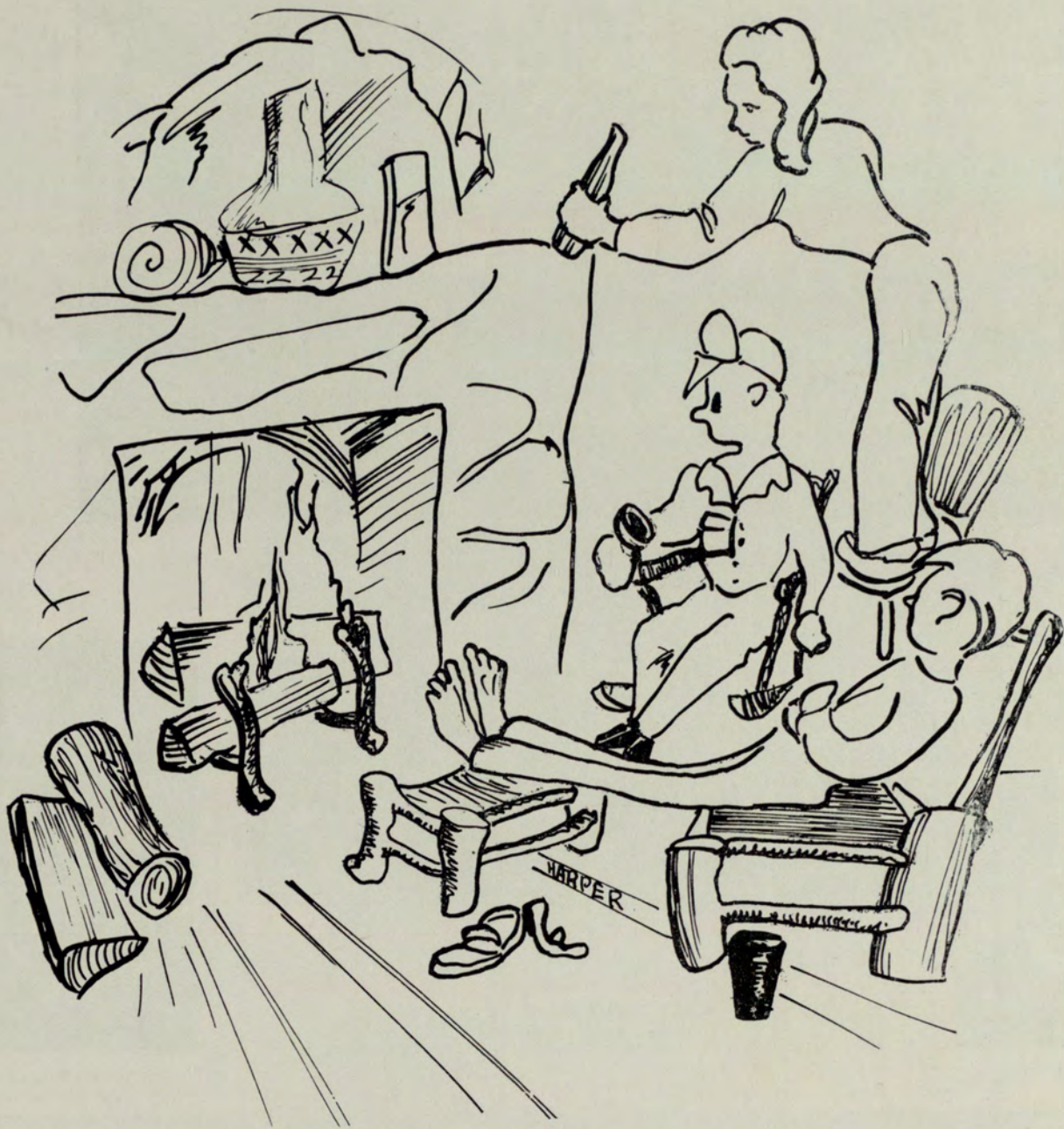
## *Greek Organizations*

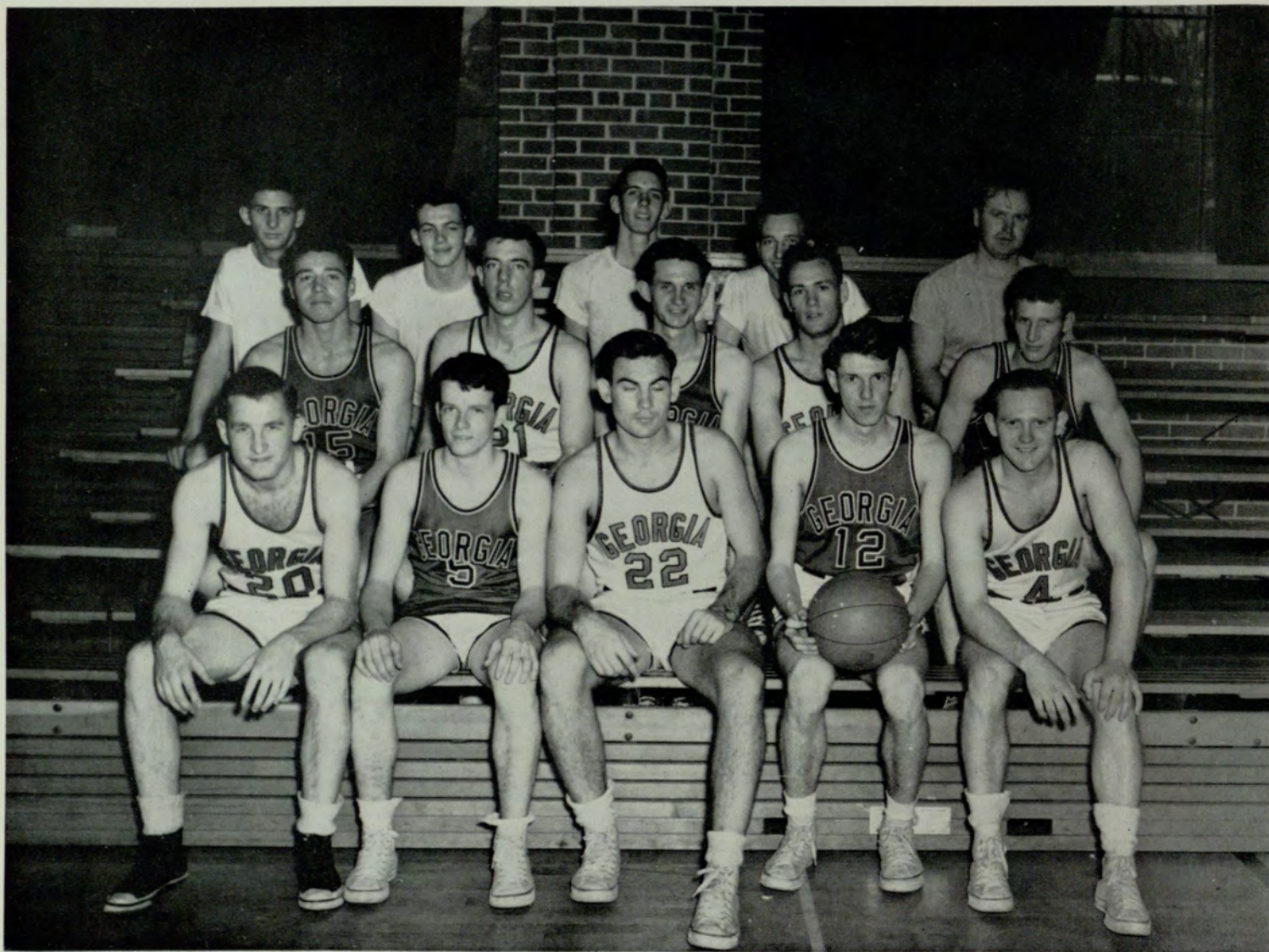

**POINT SYSTEM AND TROPHIES**

A point system covering eight sports is in operation in the league, with awards being given to the top teams in each. All participating organizations have been furnished with a plaque for their own use, showing their name, and any sport in which their team wins a high position will merit them an addition to the placque. A major cup will be awarded each year to the organization receiving the most points, denoting the athletic champion of the year. For purposes of competition a competitive year runs from January 1st to December 31st.

The number of points possible in each of the sports is determined in advance in order to keep the events in balance. The league directors determine how the points shall be divided prior to play commencing, except for bowling, softball, basketball and volleyball. The number of points is as follows: Boxing 195, Badminton 195, Golf 240, Tennis 240, Bowling 285, Volleyball 355, Basketball 495, and Softball 700. All organizations with male members attending evening classes are eligible to either furnish a team, or combine with another organization and field a team jointly.
