

DR. GEORGE M. SPARKS

Dr. George M. Sparks, a former war correspondent, has brought college education to thousands of Georgia boys and girls through the development of the Atlanta Division of the University of Georgia. He was born at Quitman, Georgia on November 19, 1889. He attended Mercer University where he recived his A.B., M.A., and LL.D. degrees. He did graduate work at Emory University, Georgia Tech, George Washington University, and Oxford, England. While at Mercer, he was active in religious and sports activities as well as being editor of the college paper.

Dr. Sparks started his career as physical education director for the Macon Y.M.C.A. Later, he became cub reporter, sports editor and state editor of the Macon Telegraph. He served as a war correspondent for the Atlanta Constitution, the Associated Press, Macon Telegraph, Savannah News, Albany Herald, and Columbus Ledger. During World War I he became Washington correspondent for the Atlanta Constitution and


Macon Telegraph. He then worked with the Washington Times, became city editor for the Telegraph, and instructor in the School of Journalism of Mercer. On September 16, 1922 romance found its way into his busy life when he married Miss Mary Booth of Fitzgerald. At the age of thirty, Dr. Sparks made Who's Who in America. In 1924 he became a teacher of Journalism at Georgia School of Technology where he later was placed in charge of the Tech Evening School. Under his capable leadership the school grew into what now is known as the Atlanta Division of the University of Georgia.

This interesting college began with one hundred sixty students, eleven professors and a sixty-five book library. Today, the college has grown to a strength of six thousand students, two hundred professors, and a large library. The college continued to expand until it outgrew three buildings. It was then moved to the present location in 1946.

The college is unique because it provides a college education for working men and women as well as boys and girls. Its student body consists of students of all ages and all works of life. Some are day students who work and some who work during the day attend school at night. While these students are completing their degrees, they receive valuable experience in their daily work in the field of business. The faculty is made up of well qualified, full-time professors and competent part-time instructors from the business and professional world. These teachers under the leadership of Dr. Sparks are making a distinct contribution to the education of the great throng of students who attend the college. Many other colleges are studying our college in an effort to find the reason for our success. "Our success can not be found; he can only be met."

Dr. Sparks is a member of several fraternal organizations such as Pi Delta Epsilon, Alpha Delta Sigma, and Phi Sigma Kappa. He is a Mason, a Kiwanian, and a member of the First Baptist Church of Atlanta, where he is chairman of the Board of Directors. He is author of several books: "Camp Cotton and Border," 1917; "War Activities," 1920, and others.

Despite his many wide-spread activities, the Atlanta Division holds the largest spot in his heart, for he can rightfully be called its master builder.

HISTORY

ATLANTA DIVISION UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA

The history of the Atlanta Division, University of Georgia, is as impressive as the plans for its new campus. The Atlanta Division began as an idea for promoting education for men and women who were in search of a college education but could not attend day classes. One hundred and sixty students were enrolled, and the faculty was made up of eleven professors. Courses offered were mainly business subjects, with languages and history added later. All of the school facilities were in the building itself.

The aim of the Atlanta Division has been accomplished by offering to thousands of young people the opportunity to gain an education while making their living. Students attending the Atlanta Division now number from 4,000 to 6,000, with a faculty composed of one hundred and fifty professors. The curriculum contains a large variety of courses, with several degrees and diplomas now being offered. The present location of the Atlanta Division at 24 Ivy Street is its third home, with school facilities now including the school lodge and the gymnasium. Students have an opportunity to enter into organizations which promote certain types of activities, both social and professional, and further business education generally.

Plans for the new home of the Atlanta Division will bring to students a magnificent structure, enclosing a new library, additional classrooms, executive offices, and student lounges, with the present building being used for laboratories and additional classroom space. The ingenuity, aggressiveness, and genuine interest of the faculty and students in the Atlanta Division will continue to make it a school of which we can all be proud.



Who's Who

The University sponsored this year a "Who's Who at the Atlanta Division." Students were nominated for their scholastic ability and student activities. From this group of eligible individuals, the faculty selected twenty-one outstanding juniors and seniors to be listed in the "Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities" for the year 1950-51. This is the first time the Atlanta Division has been given the opportunity of submitting names of its students for listing in the publication. Students pictured were nominated for "Who's Who at the Atlanta Division," and individuals selected for the "Who's Who" publication have been so designated. Sketches of their accomplishments are in this year's edition, and scrolls were presented to these students on Honors Night.

ORGANIZATIONS


Organizations at the Atlanta Division, University of Georgia, are many and their purposes varied.

There are the honorary organizations, Delta Mu Delta, composed of students who were in the top 15% of the graduating class, Intramural Key and Crimson Key for men and women students, respectively, having two years of college with an average of B. These organizations, by extending membership, bestow honor upon students for their scholastic ability.

Professional organizations are represented by Alpha Kappa Psi and Delta Sigma Pi, men's international professional fraternities in commerce, the Society for the Advancement of Management and the Atlanta Marketing Club for men students, and Phi Chi Theta, national women's commerce fraternity. 
Through the Delta Mu Delta Honor Roll, published annually, the records of students of outstanding scholastic
