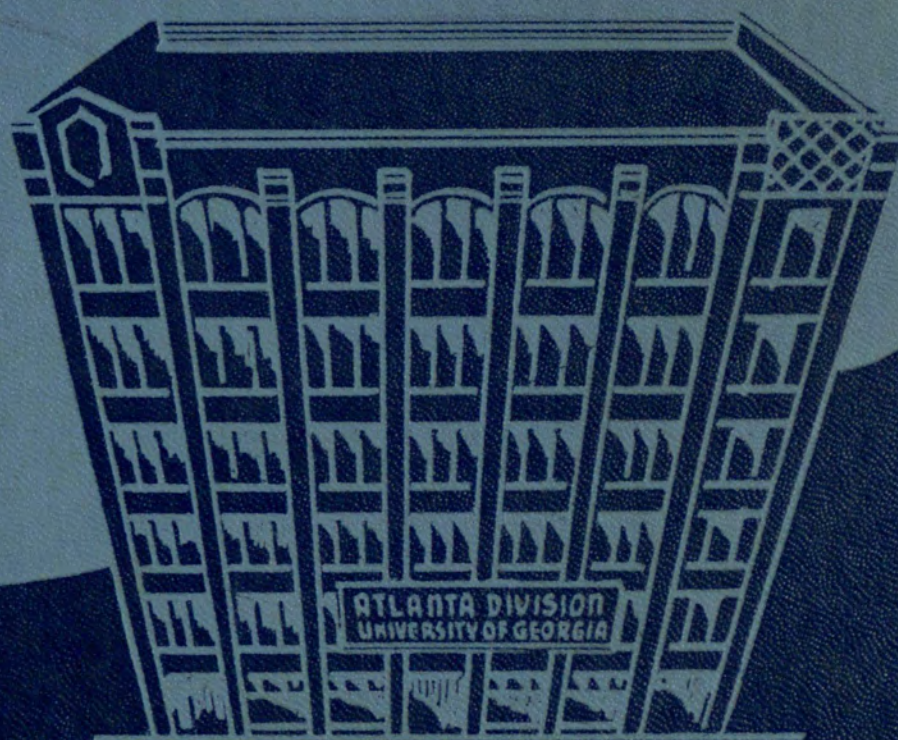

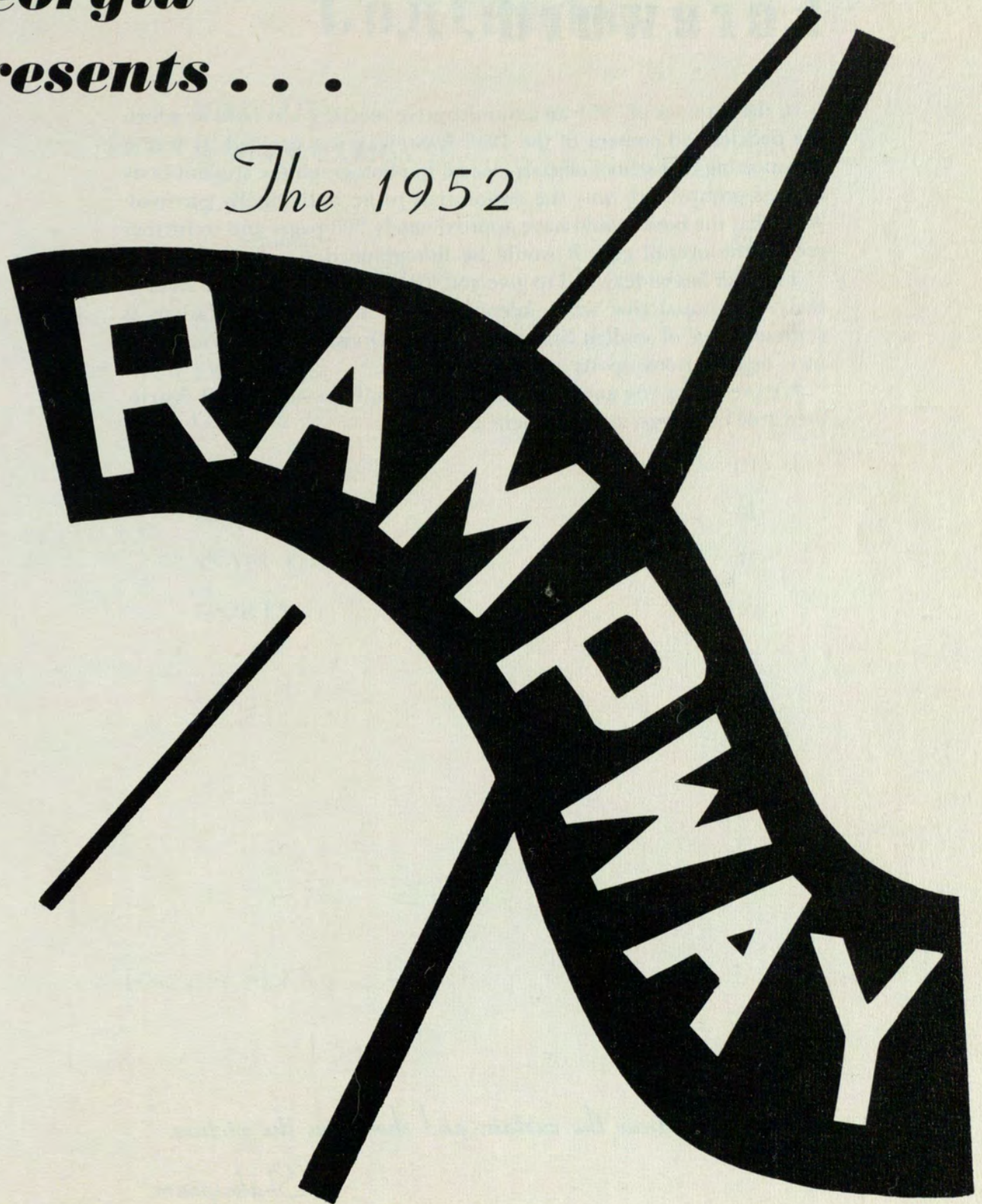

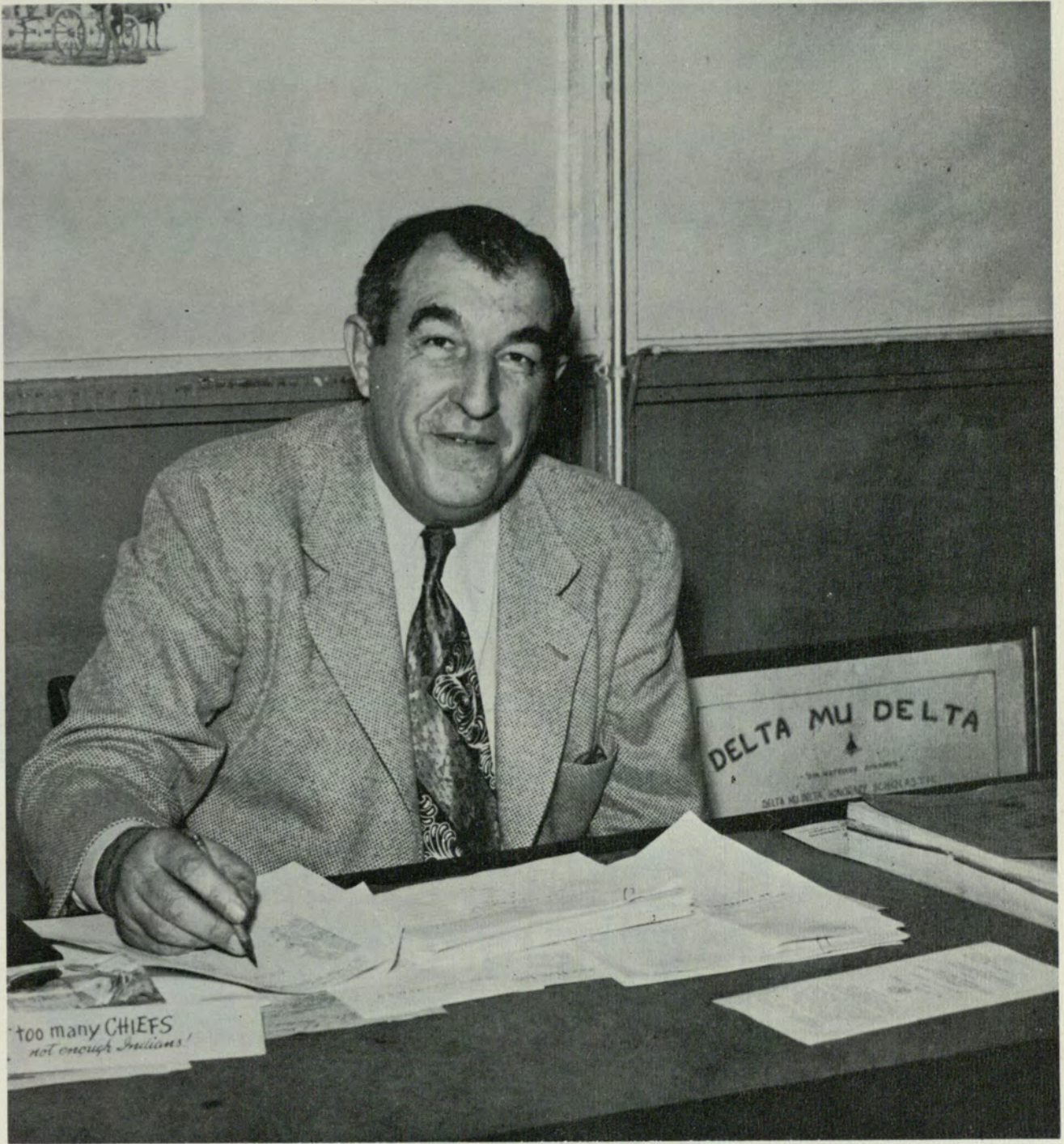
## Dedication
