Mr. Lavroff, we of the 1962 Rampway respectfully and gratefully dedicate this book to you with the accolade: For Service.












The recent action of the Board of Regents will allow the expansion of Georgia State College in the three phases pictured here.

Other annual activities are the Founders Day Banquet, Christmas Party, and "Crying Towel Party" for pledges of all sororities.


The pin is a monogram of the Greek letters of AOII and the flower is the Jacqueminot Rose.
