This unit of the University System of Georgia
has just moved in to a six-story down-town office building,
in which we have room to take care of 5000 students. Three
floors of classrooms are in order for use, but we have not
been able to obtain all of the materials to finish the
inside of the other floors yet.

Since this is a down-town college, we do not
have any dormitories. Our students, including veterans and
their wives, find accommodations in the Atlanta area. At
the present time 2500 students are enrolled, about half of
whom are veterans.
